The executive committee of the Southern Ohio Section of the American Association of Physics Teachers (SOS/AAPT) met in the faculty dining room of the Hamilton Williams Campus Center at Ohio Wesleyan University. The meeting was called to order by president F. Thomas at 12:20 PM. Those present were G. Aubrecht, B. Clemens, M. Grote, W. Kuhlman, L. Lonney, G. Minor, W. Ploughe, A. Ross, P. Shields, J. Sullivan, and F. Thomas.

F. Thomas announced that the Spring meeting will be held at Sinclair Community College on Saturday, April 24, 1999 and that he will be the contact person.

G. Aubrecht noted that few SOS/AAPT members attended the OS/APS meeting the weekend of October 15 but those that did were treated to a very nice poster session and concurrent reception. J. Sullivan noted that it was a good meeting and that it is impressive that OS/APS is very interested in meeting with SOS/AAPT whenever possible.

J. Sullivan brought the information regarding the booth at the October 11-13 SECO meeting and the executive committee discussed the plans for the presentation at the booth.
