Spring 2006 Meeting of the SOS/AAPT in Cincinnati by Lee Widmer

At the request of the Executive Board, the Spring meeting of the Southern Ohio Section of the American Association of Physics Teachers will be held on Saturday, April 8, 2006 at the OMI College of Applied Science of the University of Cincinnati. Detailed directions to the college appear later.

At the moment, we have three invited speakers. Ken Heller, President of the AAPT and Professor at the University of Minnesota, will give a talk on the Physics knowledge that engineering faculty at the University of Minnesota want their students to know. Mark Fischer of the College of Mount St. Joseph will give a talk on VideoPoint, a software program that he and his students have used to analyze motion. Heidrun Schmitzer of Xavier University will talk about her recent work in optics.

We will also have a contributed papers section. We welcome any topic of interest to Physics teachers. We already have two papers scheduled. A formal call for papers appears later.

The Tri-State Physics Teachers will be having a reorganizational meeting as part of the agenda.

There is no registration fee for this meeting. So, since there is plenty of free parking at the college, attendance at this meeting is free. A deli buffet lunch will be available at the meeting site. From I-75S - Take Exit 3 (US-52 / Hopple St.). Turn left onto Hopple St. Hopple Street becomes Martin Luther King – stay on Martin Luther King to Victory Parkway. Turn right onto Victory Parkway. The college is on the left.
