Past President Frank Huss presided as President Yerian was ill. Frank is appointed president *pro-tem* in Stephen's absence.

Minutes: Frank Huss moved and was seconded to accept minutes of Oct. 25, 2007 meeting.

Membership report: Gordon Aubrecht has identified 11 life members. Money needs to be invested in CD after incorporation is complete. We need to gather dues and generate interest in others to join & to maintain current membership. An electronic redo of Mike Grote's circular might help??

Fred is appointed to: generate a data base with info about dues dates so that emails can be posted to members who need to pay dues. Sources of info for the base includes: Email addresses from Elizabeth George, updates from Gordon Aubrecht, paper files from Jim Sullivan.

Job descriptions: At Bill Kuhlman's suggestion, it was moved and seconded that each of the present officers will provide a job description of his/her duties. President *pro-tem* Huss will 'ride herd' bringing together the documents for examination, emendation and approval at the autumn 2008 SOSAAPT meeting.

Spring 2008 Meeting April 26: Kathy Harper and Mary Whalen reported on the intended content of the spring meeting at Olentangy High School (North of Columbus OH in Delaware Co.) Please see Kathy's email for content (attached).

NSTA in Cincinnati: Kathy Harper reported that the Dec 4, 2008 meeting of the NSTA needs the help of the physics community. The dates by which to submit offerings is February 25.
