

Video Production with iMovie on the iPad

I spent about 25 minutes making a 9 minute recording. I would actually like to be able to speed up the resulting video to about half-again as fast as it is tortuously slow to listen to (at least for me). I find I cannot write very fast on the screen.

1. Turn on iPad. The power switch is just behind the edge on the top-right corner when you hold the iPad in portrait orientation with the circular button with a square in it down.
2. Be patient. We shut them completely off to save battery power.
3. Swipe to the right when you are told to.
4. Tap on the iMovie icon in the bar running across the bottom of the screen.
5. recording
 - (a) Click *Continue*
 - (b) Follow instructions on screen: tap *Projects* and then the plus sign to start a new movie.
 - (c) Choose *Movie*.
 - (d) Tap *Create* in the top right corner.
 - (e) Tap the camera icon in the lower right corner of the screen.
 - (f) You don't need to let it use your location.
 - (g) If needed, tap the camera icon with circling arrows to switch between front and back cameras.
 - (h) Click the red button when you are ready to start recording. Before you do that, check that the camera can see a reasonable area of the whiteboard you will be writing on.
 - (i) Click the same button to stop.
 - (j) Choose *Use Video* (or choose *Retake* if necessary).
 - (k) You can record several snippets by clicking the camera again.
6. editing
 - (a) You should be at a window with a view of your snippets in the left bottom.
 - (b) Click on a snippet to edit it. All I've figured out how to do is to split and the delete pieces.
7. sharing
 - (a) Click the left arrow at the top of the screen. That will take you to your movie.
 - (b) Click the box with an up arrow in it (middle of the right side of the screen).
 - (c) Choose an export size. The result ends up in the photo library.
 - (d) Click the circular button with a square on it.
 - (e) Find photos and tap on it.
 - (f) The movie will show up on the bottom part of the screen.
8. Turn off the iPad by pressing and holding the same button you used to turn it on. Stop holding when a slider appears and swipe the slider.
